The USGS Menlo Park Science Center is located at 345 Middlefield Road in Menlo Park

From San Francisco

- Exit highway 101 at Marsh Road, Atherton
- Go west to the T-junction with Middlefield Rd.
- Turn left (south)

From San Jose

- Exit highway 101 at Willow Road, Menlo Park
- Go west to Middlefield Rd.
- Turn right (north)

Enter the USGS campus at Survey Lane with large stone markers labeled “U.S. Geological Survey”
